Cookie Storage and Usage Policy

How do cookies work on websites?

Cookies are small text files created by the websites you visit and stored on your computer. They are used to make websites function more efficiently and to transmit important data to website owners. Currently, almost all websites use cookies to improve the performance of their resources.

How to manage cookies on your device?

Cookies are used to customize content and improve customer service quality. By continuing to use this site, you give your consent to the use of cookies. You can manage these files through your browser settings (see below for more information). It is important to note that deleting or blocking cookies may affect the functionality of the website and render certain components inaccessible.

How to disable cookies?

Most programs provide the option to delete or block cookies from websites. Please note that deleting all cookies will reset all website settings, including the ability to decline cookies. To disable them, the use of comparison functionality is required, which may pose additional difficulties.

What cookies are used on the West Hill Capital website?

The following types of cookies are used on the West Hill Capital website:

- Essential Cookies: These cookies are necessary for the functioning of the website, such as enabling access to secure areas of the site and utilizing its core features.
- Analytical/Administrative Cookies: These cookies collect data on how frequently the West Hill Capital website is used, the customer groups that exist, and the devices used for searching. We may also utilize externally obtained data to understand areas for improvement.
- Targeting Cookies: These cookies help us remember your preferences on the website, such as visited pages and transitions between them. We use this data to make our website and information more relevant to you.
